CODE OF CONDUCT PARTICIPANT STATEMENT

As a student participating in the _____ I understand and accept the following responsibilities when participating in all events:

- I will respect the rights and beliefs of others and will treat others with courtesy and consideration.
- I will be fully responsible for my actions (including interactions with advisors/chaperones) and the consequences of those actions.
- I will respect the property of others.
- I will respect and obey the rules of my school (including policies regarding alcohol and tobacco use), the host site, and the laws of my community, state, and country. I will be aware of my surroundings at all times.
- Transportation and rooming: I will follow my (district/state and/or national organization's) policy with regard to transportation and rooming arrangements. I will provide a signed informed consent form prior to the event if required.
- I will abide by the rules of the event. The electronic sharing of data (internet/cell phone, etc.) is prohibited. I will adhere to the competition timeline with respect to the sharing of answers and/ or scores prior to the event completion in subsequent locations.
- I will show respect for and abide by the decisions of the competition officials and host site personnel.
- I will use the proper protocol of communication and grievance procedures. Grievances are to be brought to my coach, who will in turn share the grievance(s) with the competition coordinator in writing. The Competition Coordinator(s) will then forward the written concern to the State Director if necessary. The State Director's decision is final.
- By signing this statement I acknowledge that I have read and agree to the above statements.
- I understand that failure to adhere to this Code of Conduct may result in the disqualification of me and/or the team from further participation in any event for the remainder of the academic competition season if the adherence failure occurs before the state competition. If the adherence failure occurs during the state competition, disqualification may carry over to the following season.
